These fish are not fished in the normal way, if you look normally the hook pretends to sink until it sinks completely and you pull the rod, but for the sand fish you will have to pull the rod at the first threat. It is required to complete the Fisherman's Quests at Seafront and improve Nier's fishing skill level. Here we have provided a quick yet complete guide on how to get Sandfish in Nier Replicant. Here we will tell you everything about how to track down, grab, and collect the three Sandfish you want to complete the next phase of this quest. How to Get Sandfish in Nier Replicant Luckily, you only need a simple bait to catch the Sandfish so you do not require going out and buy bait using your Gold. You can catch Sandfish by fishing in the Sandsea near Façade, you need to fish at the dock which is situated at the spot where you can use the fast travel boat. This is the only location where you will find Sandfish. Here we have given the detail more specifically. Once you're in the quest, you need to go to the Desert area which is the last region before you reach Façade. You will see a dock in the South Western corner. Stand near the boat and throw your rod and start fishing there. By using your Lure, you will be able to catch the 3 Sandfish. This part is quite tricky as there are a lot of junks to catch also there are some hard fish which do not seem possible here. So, catch sufficient number of fishes and you will ultimately find your Sandfish amongst them. Once you get Sandfish, press Circle on PS or B on Xbox to reel it in. After that, pull off the left analog stick towards you, in the opposite direction of the ripple in the water. Thus, Sandfish are pretty simple to reel in. Note that unlike most fish, you will have to reel in the line at the very first movement of the float (picture4). picture2 picture3 picture4 The Fisherman's Technique, Part 7: Catch 3 Royal Fish Go to the Eastern Road and fish from the rocks along the river using Earthworms to catch Royal Fish (pictures5-6). picture5 picture6 The Fisherman's Gambit, Part 8: Catch 2 Blue Marlin You can catch these rare fish from the beach next to the old fisherman using Lures (pictures7-8). You can also catch them from the dock where the old fisherman is by using Sardines (picture9). Note that like the Sandfish, you will have to reel in the line at the first movement of the float to catch Blue Marlin. picture7 picture8 picture9 The Fisherman's Final Gambit: Catch a Hyneria To catch this very rare fish, buy at least 20 Sardines from the Tackle Shop, and then head for the desert pier (picture10). Fish here with your Sardines to have a chance to catch the Hyneria (pictures11-12). Note that this fish will pull the float two times before taking it deeper. Knowing this, you can remove your line if the float's behavior proves different to avoid wasting your bait. picture10 picture11 picture12 When you are done with this last step of the quest, you can return to Seafront to learn about the death of the old fisherman (picture13). Each fishing location has its own species, and each of these prefers certain baits. To successfully complete The Fisherman's Gambit side quests, players will need to catch most of the available species of fish, including the elusive Sandfish and Blue Marlin.How to fish in Nier Replicant ver. 1.22Fishing seems easy enough in Nier Replicant. Players can get a fishing rod from the old man in Seafront as part of the main story. However, after obtaining the Shaman Fish, there's a nine-part side quest available from the Old Fisherman that'll have players taking on increasingly harder challenges.To catch a fish, all players have to do is wait until the right moment and either pull back on the left stick or tap O. Then, they need to hold the left stick in the opposite direction that the fishing is pulling until the meter at the bottom depletes.However, knowing when to hook the fish isn't as easy as just watching the bobber dip below the water. Each fish has a different tell. The bobber will only dip a maximum of three times before the cast fails. However, players must hook some fish on the first or second dip. Additionally, whether the bobber gets a soft or hard tug helps identify which fish species is nibbling at a player's bait.Note that Nier starts as a pretty poor fisherman. However, each time players complete one of the Fisherman's Gambit side quests, he gets better. So, those who are having difficulty nabbing a fish might want to wait until they've completed all these quests and try again.Nier Replicant fishing locations listin the table below, we've gathered info on every fish species in Nier Replicant, what bait it likes, and how to hook it. This is likely the first fish that'll give players issues because it isn't apparent when the hook should be set. To catch a Sandfish, head to the desert near the boat. Players should cast their rods (with Sardines as bait preferably). The tricky part here is that the rod doesn't dip when it's time to hook the Sandfish. Instead, players should try and time setting the hook with the first bob. If done correctly, the Sandfish will be on the line, and it's a relatively easy struggle from there.How to catch the Blue Marlin in Nier Replicant ver. 1.22The Blue Marlin is another tough fish to hook in Nier Replicant. However, the process of catching it is similar to that used to get the Sandfish. It's located off the piers in Seafront. Using Sardines, cast the rod and attempt a hook on the first bite. This should hook a Blue Marlin, and the process of reeling it in won't be too challenging. The game gives you no reel clues on where to find the fish, let alone what bait you need to hook them in. You could spend all your time casting a line only to realize you're in the wrong spot, or you could read this guide which details all the fish in the game and where to find them.Be smart. Choose the second option.Nier Replicant fish: Rainbow trout, bream, and everything else you need Early Prime Day deals: see all the best early offers right here.There's no real impetus to go fishing in Nier Replicant other than it's an enjoyable detour from the usual Shade-slaying and it is required for a particular series of quests called The Fisherman's Gambit. There's also a special achievement, called The Fish of Legend, that you get for catching a particular fish. So if you want to 100 percent the game (including beating all the side quests), you're going to have to spend some time fishing.This quest is given to you by an old man in Seafront who is standing on the pier by the smaller of the two beaches (the one in front of the main street with all the shops). Each time you complete one of the parts of the quest, your fishing skills will level up. This will let you catch even harder fish. We'll explain all of that further below, but for now here's all the fish needed for each step of The Fisherman's Gambit in Nier Replicant, including where to find them and what bait they require. The other required you to catch an ultra rare fish called a Rhizodont, which unlocks a special achievement.The Rhizodont will put your fishing skills to the test, however. So don't even bother trying to hook one until after you've completed The Fisherman's Gambit. This is because there's a hidden fishing skill that levels up with each phase of the quest that makes it easier to catch fish. Even with your fishing skill maxed out, the Rhizodont will take around a minute or so to weaken enough to reel it in. If you don't have a maxed out fishing skill, though, that could take a lot longer.Once you've completed The Fisherman's Gambit, here are the next steps:Buy sardines from the bait store in Seafront (I'd bring about 25).Go to the fishing spot right next to the fast travel boat in the Desert.Begin fishing using the sardines.You're going to catch a lot of junk like empty buckets and tin cans.The other fish in this area is the Hyneria (required for the final stage of The Fisherman's Gambit). You can tell you've hooked a Hyneria based on how quickly its stamina depletes. If the meter is moving extremely slowly, you've likely hooked a Rhizodont.A controller is recommended so you can use vibrations to guide you to make sure you're always positioning your rod. The Rhizodont will easily break your line if you don't keep up with its erratic movements.Be patient. It'll likely take you a few tries and some luck.Fishing is a pretty fun game but it can be frustrating if you don't know what you're doing. The minigame is broken into two phases: First you cast your line and wait for a fish to take a proper bite out of it and then you pull in the opposite direction the fish is moving to weaken it until you can reel it in.Fishing spots are found in a few specific locations and each one has a unique type of fish that can only be caught with a specific type of bait.You should use a controller because the feedback from the vibrations is super helpful. Especially when trying to catch harder fish, there's a subtle difference in the intensity of the vibration that helps you know when your rod is in the optimal position.Vibrations can also help you know when a fish is eating your bait and not nibbling at it. If you try to reel it in too soon, you'll miss the fish and lose your bait. Normally you can tell when a fish bites because your rod will bend and the float will sink beneath the water, but in my experience this didn't always work. But there is a distinctly strong vibration when a fish bites, so you can use that to gauge when to reel in a catch.One last bit of advice is that once you catch a fish and turn it in for The Fisherman's Gambit quest, the nearby fish merchant will sell that fish. It's a great way to restock on fish that double as bait, like sardines, instead of fishing manually for them. I've tried about 40 times per bait.
