Understanding these factors helps candidates get a clearer picture of why their states score looks the way it does.Vacancies in each state heavily shape the cut off, fewer seats often mean a higher qualifying score.If the exam paper turns out tougher than expected, the cut off usually dips, and the opposite happens when the paper is easy.States with a larger number of applicants often see sharper competition, which impacts the final numbers.The overall performance trend of candidates also influences where IBPS sets the minimum marks.
