Members are elected by the Board of Directors on the advice of the Administrative Committee and by the Council of Presidents appointed by the Regional Soviets and the Council. The International Diploma School has been well received. IN 2013Education, culture, sports, science and technology Japan and IB have announced a plan that will increase the ability of Japanese students to complete the IB training program in Japanese. [58] The help of local organizations [59] in Russia has thirteen days of IB schools. In Spain, different models (3 types of Spanish schools: public, private schools and state-funded or subsidized schools) have been introduced, resulting in a significant increase in 140 schools. [60] Internationally, IB is continued to be recognized as innovative; The World Innovation Summit for Education (Wise) announced that the IB-related certificate is a finalist at the annual Wise Awards. [61] However, in 2020 IB received strict criticism worldwide for controversial assessments as the Covid-19 measures prevented the examination of the exams. [62] According to the 7acad Higher Education Agency, the average high school diploma is 4.54 points and a total of 5 years at least 28.51 points 2019.
