But this is a poor strategy. The holidays are extremely predictable: They happen at the same time every year. Why not save all year round for this annual expenditure, rather than wait until October or November? See an account for travel and gifts So, what can you do now that can help you be better prepared for next year's holiday? Open a savings account that is intended for holiday trips and gifts. Online banks like SmartyPig and Capital One 360 let you open multiple "sub" accounts, each marked for a specific purpose. Contribute \$20 or \$30 per month (or more) to this account. Automatically withdraw this money from your current account. By the end of the year, you will get \$240 (at \$20 per month) or \$360 (at \$30 per month). Just fill the gas tank and drive to the house of your relatives with a trunk full of gifts. Do not quit this year Although time is growing short, you can still save for this year if you work hard at it. The first step is to drastically cut current expenditure. Do you usually eat in restaurants every Friday night? Do you buy beer, chips or drinks from the supermarket? Cut out these lumps. Put the savings in your holiday fund. Next, collect a little extra weekend work, such as baby-sitting, sewing meadows or raking leaves. Place all extra income in your holiday fund. Once you save this year's funds, start preparing for next year, setting those accounts with automatic withdrawal. One of the gods the things of the holidays is the surprise that comes with a gift, all wrapped and full of mystery. The holidays also bring with it the comfort of the family, to serve and to be served good food and drinks. At office parties, Christmas eve meetings and Hanukkah dinners, and until New Year's Eve, most of us indulge in the delights of the table, the punch bowl and the cellar. This year, if you're like me, you might want a new kind of joy, something a little cooler than Uncle John's Manhattan, that mixed from the days of Iwo Jima, or a little more frosted than the hot toddy Charles Dickens drank after receiving his first check for "A Christmas Carol". To this end, I asked some of America's largest chefs, restaurateurs and wine experts to suggest new mixed drinks, unfamiliar wines, new ways to use Champagne and Kentucky bourbon. For a sense of journalistic responsibility towards you, the exemplary reader of the Fast Company, I tasted everything our team of experts recommended. Five New-Fashioned» This is the challenge I launched at Jean-Georges Vongerichten, 41, appointed James Bee of 1998. The exceptional chef of the Foundation (the Oscar version for the best actor in the world of food) and whose restaurant Jean Georges won this year the prize for the best new restaurant of the foundation. I have long been a devotee to the Old Fashioned, which is made with rye whiskey or bourbon. The oranges and cherries of this classic cocktail look perfect for both a Christmas drink and a summer cooler. Chef Vongerichten, who resembles French George Clooney, is ready for testing. "Give me a week and I'll give you a new holiday drink," she promises. It turns out, however, that instead of offering a single drink, he invented a handful of cocktails. The sommelier of Jean Georges, Kurt Eckert, 42 years old, and I taste these festive drinks in the new chef's four-star restaurant. The New-Fashioned features crushed blueberries and sliced red oranges – an innovative combination for a drink, even if you could find in a fruit dessert. Red blueberries and red oranges both have a fruity but bitter quality, which Vongerichten thinks fits well with appetizers: the fruit prepares the tongue for the sweetness and salt of most finger food predinner. The use of ice cubes based on cranberry juice further enhances the taste. A similar idea is at work in its Frozen Fire Champagne Cocktail, which uses ice cubes based on cranberry juice and Tabasco sauce to form a delicious champagne complement mixed with a little sugar. At the first taste, we think that the drink might need a pinch of fruit and spicy chili, so Vongerichten throws in ice cubes until thet doesn't look like a lava lamp. Continuing in the champagne vein, Vongerichten prescribes a mixture of Pears, pear liqueur, black pepper and champagne. The result, called the champagne pear pepper cocktail, is dense, sweet, and sparkling enough to be refreshing.dan of the old, 31, which came back this year by a tour of duty in Vong, the Franco-Thai restaurant Of Vongerichten in London, he prepares a neo-rum fist with homemade tamarind water. The fist has the aromatic spice of Eggnog and the tangosità of the fruit. A duster of nutmeg overtakes the fist, delivering a spicy blow when you take that first sip.Vonderichten also slips even a final surprise drink under my tree: a Jerez Martini, mixed with a splash of amongillado Á e à, ~ Á "Los Arcos" Lustau Sherry. This is an adult drink Á e à, ~ innocent sugar. All of these spring drinks from the fertile mind of a great culinary artist, but the principles that drive can also guide you. After all, even the lowest and scotch-on-the-rocks drinker should taste the fruits of the Savvy mixology at least once a year. But there is more vacation conviviality than mixed drinks. Even if you are not one Of the lucky you receive the day free for a federal holiday, you have to track these days to plan everything, holidays and non-school days to make commissions. A holiday that includes a vacation pot It would mean that you have one day more with the pay - or your favorite destination is much more crowded than usual. And you certainly don't want to waste time driving a day when it's closed. In the u.s., both federal and state governments can declare public holidays that give employees of government and companies supported by the government as banks, schools and DMV offices the day off. Starting from 2020, the US government officially recognizes 10 federal festivities, most of which are also recognized by the United States.
